NOTICE OF SEWER RATE INCREASE

In March of 2023, MN Rural Water completed an analysis of the city's sewer and water rate structure relative to operating costs and debt service requirements. The study showed that water usage rates should be set at \$3.43/1,000 gallons and sewer usage rates should be set at \$7.32/1,000 gallons.

In response to the study, at their March 2023 meeting, the Avon City Council voted to increase the water usage fee from \$3.06/1,000 gallons to \$3.43/1,000 gallons. At that same time, based on feedback from residents and businesses, the sewer rate was raised from \$5.03 to \$6.03 per 1,000 gallons with the intention that the council would raise rates to \$7.32/1,000 gallons at the end of this year making the increase more incremental and perhaps less of a burden all at once.

At their meeting November 6th, the city council did vote unanimously to implement the sewer rate increase to \$7.32/1,000 gallons. The increase will be on your February bill for usage during December and January. Prior to 2023, the rates had not been increased since 2018.

Try this simple test to find out if your toilet is silently leaking water (and costing you money!). All you need is dark food coloring and an old towel.


- 1) Put an old towel around the base of the toilet just in case, dye can stain flooring.
