

Utility Billing and City Newsletter

Watch for changes to your utility bill. On the reverse side of this newsletter you will find a copy of your bill with your CURRENT balance. (The next bill will be going out on June 1.) Note the amount next to "AMOUNT DUE NOW". If there is an amount due then this amount is PAST DUE and includes current penalties. Please pay the amount by May 23 to avoid additional late fees. If the BALANCE is \$0.00 or a negative amount then you owe nothing at this time.

The utility bills will now be sent out every other month and contain two months' worth of access fees and well as two months' of water/sewer usage. It will be printed on white paper, instead of this blue, but will be folded the same. When you receive your bill, please detach the bottom portion and return it with your payment by the due date.

Sewer averaging (for RESIDENTIAL billing only) will apply on the June, August and October bills. This will include usage from between April 16 through October 15. In other words, any water used between April 16 and October 15, will be billed the average sewer amount based on usage from October 16 through April 15.

There will no longer be an "All About Avon" City/Township newsletter published at this time. There, will however, be a short City newsletter included with the utility bill.

The changes are due to budget cuts and will be a savings cost for postage, printing and staff time.

ATTENTION: ALL DOG OWNERS!!!

Spring is upon us and the police department has already received numerous dog complaints. As a reminder to all dog owners please abide by the following ordinances:

- ◆ All dogs over six months old MUST be licensed. Licenses are due yearly, cost \$5.00 and can be purchased at the city hall. Please supply proof of current vaccinations when applying.
- ◆ It is unlawful for your dog to bark habitually (meaning intervals of at least five minutes without one minute of interruption).
- ◆ The owner of an animal is responsible for cleaning up after their pet whether on their own property, the property of others, or on public property.
- ◆ All animals must be kept under the control and direction of a responsible person, so as to be effectively restrained by command as by leash.
